Cookie Dough



Every Girl Scout who sells 50 packages or more earns Cookie Dough. This is an earned award and added value to the Girl Scout's family. This can be used for the following: Council-sponsored program events, day camps, resident camps, Destinations and Council trips, and Council Store purchases. Cookie Dough can be shared by siblings only. Cookie Dough is not cumulative and does **expire on September 30, 2010.**

****** Plus for every additional 200 boxes sold over the 1000 level, girls will receive an additional \$50.00 in cookie dough. ******

Resident Camp and Trip Bonus Credit (is not cumulative for camp) The bonus credit corresponds to the highest recognition level the girl achieved. It can only be applied towards resident camp fees and Council sponsored trips. This is in addition to the Cookie Dough amount earned.
